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ORDER

University vide paper read (1) above, invited applications for continuation of provisional affiliation for the academic year 2019-20 from affiliated institutions. The Principal, Mount Zion Medical College Hospital, pathanmthitta-MM029 vide paper read (2) above submitted application for the continuation of provisional affiliation for the year 2019-20.

2. On verification of the application it is found that the college has submitted necessary documents and remitted fee for the Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the academic year 2019-20. The inspection commission, vide paper read (3) above, has submitted inspection report after conducting the inspection. After scrutinizing the inspection report, the Scrutiny Committee vide paper read (4) above pointed out that there are deficiencies with respect to Faculty. The deficiencies were intimated to the college and vide paper read (5) above, the college submitted compliance report claiming that they had rectified the deficiencies pointed out during the inspection. After receiving the compliance report, University conducted re-inspection at the college. The inspection commission, vide paper read (6) above, submitted inspection report after conducting re inspection. After scrutinizing the inspection report, the Scrutiny Committee vide paper read (7) above pointed out that there are deficiencies with respect to faculty and residents and not recommended to grant Continuation of Provisional Affiliation to the college for the year 2019-20.

3. Considering the representations from the college, Governing Council vide paper read (8) above, decided to grant continuation of provisional affiliation to Mount Zion Medical College, Pathanamthitta on condition that the college shall make an interest free deposit of Rs One Crore (as DD/Bank Transfer) to the University as a guarantee and shall execute an undertaking in the stamp paper by the Chairman/Secretary of the Trust and the Principal to the effect that the institution will comply with all the requirements of the University. The college, vide paper read (9) above, has submitted an undertaking in the stamp paper accepting the conditions laid down by the Governing Council and remitted Rs 1 crore to the University. The college has submitted renewal recognition from the Ministry



of Health & Family Welfare for conducting the MBBS course and the order reconstituting the College Council for the Academic year 2019-20.

4. Sanction, has therefore been accorded by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor by implementing the decision no 55.33 of 55th Governing Council to grant Conditional continuation of provisional affiliation to Mount Zion Medical College Hospital, Pathanamthitta-MM029 for conducting the following course with an annual intake of students mentioned against it during the academic year 2019-20 subject to the conditions detailed below:-

- 1 The Governing Council of the University has decided that University will conduct a surprise inspection at the College in due course to ensure that the deficiencies pointed out in the inspection should be rectified. If the college fails to rectify the deficiencies, the University will forfeit the amount of Rs 1 crore remitted by the College and no claim for the forfeited amount shall be entertained. The University will conduct only one inspection in connection with the continuation of Provisional affiliation for the academic year 2020-21 and if that also fails Continuation of Affiliation for 2020-21 will not be granted to the college..

The following deficiencies of faculty shall be rectified urgently

(1) Professor-4 (TB-1, Radio Diagnosis-1, General Medicine -1, Paediatrics-1) (2) Associate Professor-7 (Anatomy-1, Physiology-1, Micro biology-1, Community Medicine-2, Psychiatry-1, Dentistry-1) (3) Assistant Professor-8 (Pathology-2, Paediatrics-1, Gen Surgery-3, OBG-1, Anaesthesiology-1) (4) Tutor-17 (Anatomy-3, Physiology-3, Bio Chemistry-3, Pathology-2, Micro Biology-3, Forensic Medicine-1, Comm Medicine-1, Pharmacology-1) (5) Junior Resident-26 (Gen Med-8, Paediatrics-3, DVL-1, Psychiatry-1, Gen Surgery-3, Orthopaedics-4, OBG-3, Anaesthesiology-3) (6) Senior Resident-7 (Gen Medicine-1, Psychiatry-1, Gen Surgery-2, Anaesthesiology-2, Radio Diagnosis-1) (7) Epidemiologist-1 (Community Medicine)

- 2 Selection, admission and collection of fees shall be made only on the basis of the rules and regulations of the University/Govt. of Kerala and on the basis of the direction issued by the University from time to time, failing which the affiliation granted will be cancelled.
In the light of the direction of the Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition(c) 656/1998, the institution shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form. In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging, appropriate action including withdrawal of affiliation of the College will be initiated.
- 3 Affiliation granted is strictly provisional and only for the academic year 2019-20. The college has to apply for continuation of provisional affiliation for the ensuing years remitting the fee fixed by the University, along with a copy of letter of approval from the apex bodies concerned.
- 4 The College should remit annual administration fee fixed for UG/PG course for the academic year 2019-20
- 5 Admission to the next academic year shall be made only after obtaining prior permission from the University.
