Profile:

The Mount Zion Medical College was established in the year 2012 by the Society, “The Charitable Educational and Welfare Society” at Chayalode, Ezhamkulam, Adoor; a green, calm, quiet and serene area flourished in 32.51 acres. The Medical College is about 10 Km away from Adoor and can be reached by road from Adoor or Pathanapuram. The Medical College is affiliated to the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS), approved by the Government of Kerala and Government of India Medical Council of India has granted permission for starting MBBS course from 2014-15. The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India/ Medical Council of India has permitted to conduct MBBS course for 100 admissions annually at MZMC, Adoor. The institution has been recognized for the MBBS Degree with effect from February 2019 onwards and approved for MBBS Admission for 5 years from 2019 onwards[No.U.12012/192/2019-ME.I (FTS.8006678)] dated 09.05.2019. The institution got Letter of Permission from National Medical Commission for an increase of seats from 100 to 150 for the academic year 2023 – 2024 (No. NMC/UGI/2023-24/000022/011992 Dated 14.03.2023)

I. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. This Prospectus relates to admission to PG Course for the Academic year 2023-24 in Mount Zion Medical College, Adoor.
- 1.2. This Prospectus contains the rules and regulations for admission to the seats to be filled by the different quotas to MS and MD Course in MZMC, Adoor, for the academic year 2023-24.
- 1.3. The Prospectus is subject to modification/ addition/ deletion as may be deemed necessary by the Management.
- 1.4. The admission will be as per National Medical Commission regulations and orders of Appropriate Authorities/ Government of Kerala/ Honourable Courts relating to the matter.
- 1.5. The candidates are required to go through the Prospectus carefully and familiarize themselves with all relevant information. They are also encouraged to visit the official Website of the College, i.e. www.mountzionmedicalcollege.com for more details.
- 1.6. **Duration of Course:** Duration of the PG Course is 3 years with a compulsory.

Senior Residency programme of 12 months following the course. The date of commencement of the course and the last date of completion of admission process will be as per the time schedule fixed by the Government of India/ NMC/ Supreme Court of India. The course will commence on the date fixed by Government.

1.7. **Dress Code:** Two piece scrubs.

II. CATEGORISATION OF SEATS

Total Number of seats: The seat available for admission to the first year is categorized as:-minority quota and will alternate with Government quota.

Single Window admission:

The seat will be admitted by the commissioner of entrance examination as per the decisions of the Honorable Supreme court of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare – Government of Kerala and Government of India.

III JOINING THE COLLEGE

Students allotted to Mount Zion Medical College should report to the Principal on the date stipulated by Controller of Entrance Examinations.

IV FURNISHING OF FALSE INFORMATION:

Furnishing of false information/particulars would result in the forfeiture of the candidature as well as cancellation of admission to the course, if admitted, and in addition, will attract the relevant provisions of criminal law of the land.

V ADMISSION

5.1 The Managements will have the right to deny admission to any applicant, if it is found that their character and antecedents are found to be questionable on genuine grounds. In such cases, the reasons for the same will be recorded and communicated to the student concerned.

5.2 Candidates are advised to visit the website of the college

www.mountzionmedicalcollege.com regularly for announcements and instructions, and to appear for admission as notified therein. No separate communication will be sent in this connection.

- 5.3 Selected candidates shall take admission at the appointed time and date in the College after remitting tuition fees, admission fee and special fees for the first year, failing which the offer of admission will be cancelled. Candidates who get allotment shall appear before the Principal of the College and submit all documents in original at the time of admission.
- 5.4 **Certificates/documents** in original to be submitted at the time of admission.
- (i) Hall ticket of PG NEET, allotment memo, mark list, data sheet.
 - (ii) Admit card of the NEET 2023.
 - (iii) Result/ Score Card of the NEET 2023.
 - (iv) SSLC/ Xth Standard Certificate.
 - (v) Mark list of the qualifying examination (MBBS or equivalent).
 - (vi) Completion Certificate of CRMI.
 - (vii) Transfer certificate (TC) and Migration Certificate from the institution last attended.
 - (viii) Copy of birth certificate of the candidate to prove his/ her date of birth.
 - (ix) Course and conduct certificate from the institution last attended certified within the last six months.
 - (x) Copy of Aadhar card
 - (xi) Certificate of Nativity filled up.
 - (xii) 2 Stamp papers of Rs.200/- denomination each (one for guarantee for payment of subsequent fees in the format given in **Annexure I**, agreeing to pay the fees fixed. And one for liquidated damages in the form given in **Annexure II**, agreeing to pay the liquidated damages of Rupees One Core in case the candidate discontinues the course at any time after the last date of admission. Stamp papers are to be purchased in the name of candidate.
 - (xiii) Anti ragging Undertaking (**Annexure III**)
 - (xiv) Undertaking in plain white paper, for undertaking not to give or receive dowry (**Annexure IV**).
 - (xv) Medical Physical **Fitness** Certificate in the format given in **Annexure V** obtained from a Registered Medical Practitioner.
 - (xvi) Vaccination certificate (HBV, MMR and Chicken Pox)
 - (xvii) Receipt of fees already paid.
 - (xviii) Passport size colour photo (150x200 pixels, displaying name and date of birth of candidate at the bottom) - 10 nos.
 - (xix) Eligibility/ equivalency certificate obtained from the Kerala University of Health Sciences by candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from authorities other than the State of Kerala / CBSE / ISCE.
 - (xx) Income certificate issued by the competent authority if applicable.
 - (xxi) Certificates / documents as a proof for claiming admission under reservation category / Community certificate for Minority quota - SEBC/ SC / ST quota as necessary.
 - (xxii) Originals of certificates from NRI candidates to prove the status

of the NRI sponsor and declaration of the NRI in the prescribed form to establish his/her relationship with the candidate.

- a. Attested copy of the relevant pages of the Passport containing Visa details.
- b. Attested copy of the Employment Certificate.
- c. Certificate issued by a Scheduled Bank stating that sponsor (he/she) is a Non resident Indian holding an NRI account other than a Zero balance account.
- d. Declaration from the NRI Sponsor of the applicant as stipulated in the government order quoted above.
- e. Certificate from the Village officer/ revenue authorities to prove the relationship between the applicant & NRI.

(xxiii) Document/ certificate required in proof of any other benefit claimed by the candidate.

(xxiv) Any other document/ certificate required to be produced.

Note: Three copies of the originals and scanned copies of the originals in a SD format should be produced. Candidates will not be given any extension of time to produce the original documents/ certificates and or for payment of fees including interest free refundable deposit or for production of bank guarantee. All certificates/ documents to be produced for admission shall be attested by a Gazetted officer/ head of the institution, where the student had studied.

VI PAYMENT OF FEES

6.1. **Fee Structure** for PG Courses (2023 admission) for the whole duration of the course will be as per rules. The fees (tuition & miscellaneous) are to be paid every year for three years (subject to clearance from Government/subject to ratification by the admission supervisory committee/ Fee Regulatory Committee and Government of Kerala) No relaxation is given in remittance of fees.

The number of seats for the different categories of government quota, OBC/ OEC/ SEBC, SC/ST, Minority and NRI Quota will be as per the decision of Government.

Annual Tuition Fees

Students in **State Merit & Minority Quotas - Rs. 17,61,665/-**(Seventeen Lakhs Sixty One Thousand Six Hundred and Sixty Five only)

Students in **NRI Quotas - Rs. 37,01,600/-**(Thirty Seven Lakhs One Thousand Six Hundred only)

(Subject to final decision of the Hon. Courts)

In addition to tuition fees, Miscellaneous fees (Special fees) prescribed by the Management/ University/ other statutory bodies (like exam fee, registration fee, etc.), caution deposit shall be paid in actual during admission as well as each year for 3 years as required. The candidate has to pay fees every academic year for three years irrespective of promotion to next class.

All the above fees are subject to the approval of the Fee Regulatory Committee.

Tuition fees and all other fees for the first year shall be paid at the time of admission and periodically each year. The candidate has to pay fees every academic year for three years irrespective of promotion to next class. Fee once paid will not be refunded. All students, including the SC/ST/OBC candidates, will have to pay the same fee as shown in this prospectus. All fee payable at the time of admission shall be paid through online

Generally, no fee relaxation or exemption from payment of fee and deposit and submission of Fee Payment Guarantee will be granted to the applicants. However, fee concession may be given to selected candidates below poverty line. Number of such concessions will be limited to 10% of the seat in the State Merit. Such candidates should be eligible for admission, in the order of their rank in General Merit. The management reserves the right to deny the claims for such concessions, if found not genuine.

Yearly remittance of fee for the normal duration of course is mandatory. The candidate must furnish bank guarantee for tuition fees for the subsequent years, at the time of admission to the effect that the tuition fees for the subsequent years will be paid before the 31st of July every corresponding year. Any delay in the payment of fees will entail a fine at the rate of 8% per annum of the amount to be paid.

If a student admitted to this Institution wishes to discontinue the course after the last day of admission, he/ she is liable to pay on demand all the fees bound to be paid by the student till the end of the course along with miscellaneous/ special fees together with the liquidated damages of **Rs. 1,00,00,000/-** (Rupees One Core only). One bonds worth Rs.200/- (specimen attached as **Annexure II**) have to be executed by student and concerned parent on admission relating to payment of fees regularly and in the event of discontinuing, **liquidated damages** if liable to pay. No relaxation is given in remittance of fees.

6.2. Cancellation of Admission/ Refund of Fees

No request for refund of fees received within a period of five days prior to the date of closure of admission to the MD/ MS course fixed by the National Medical Commission will be entertained. Refund of fees will be applicable only to students who leave the College on or before five days prior to the last date for closing of admission for MBBS fixed by the National Medical Commission. In such cases, the refund will be made within five days of the receipt of request thereof.

If any applicant discontinues the course or leaves the Institution within a period of five days before the closing of admission in the 1st year or discontinues the course/ leaves the institution in the subsequent years, he/she is liable to pay the fees for the remaining years i.e. fees for the whole course. In such cases, Transfer Certificate and other certificates will be issued only after payment of all dues including the fees for the remaining years.

In addition to the above, such students will have to pay tuition, hostel, mess and other fees proportionately for the period they remained on the rolls of the college. For the purpose of calculations of proportionate recovery, part of a month will be considered as a full month.

VII COMMENCEMENT OF COURSE

The academic year is from the 1st of August to 31st of July. The date of commencement of the course on the date fixed by Government of Kerala and National Medical Commission (NMC) and the last date of admission process will be as per the time schedule fixed by the Government of Kerala/ Government of India/ National Medical Commission/ Supreme Court of India.

VIII. SPECIAL FEATURES/ DISCIPLINE/ ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

8.1. Course Duration comprises of 3 years of academic programme and 12 months of Compulsory Senior Residency in the Mount Zion Medical College.

8.2. Vaccination: All students who get selected should be **vaccinated** against hepatitis (A+B), Chicken pox, Covid and MMR before admission. A certificate to the effect has to be submitted at the time of admission or before commencement of the course.

8.3 Medium of instruction will be English.

8.4. Discipline: All students, who are selected, should obey the rules & regulations of the Institution without fail. Students are expected to observe absolute discipline in their conduct during the entire period they spend in the institution. Failure to observe absolute discipline will invite appropriate disciplinary action. Any act of indiscipline involving **smoking, drinking alcohol, consumption of habituating drugs and abetting or involving in immoral activities** by even a single student is detrimental to the healthy metamorphosis of the other normal students into true professionals. This cannot be permitted. Any such acts of indiscipline either inside the campus or outside during the whole duration of the course will be considered very seriously. Such act will put the student in the Blacklist of the institution; entail immediate dismissal from the hostel and curbing of all freedom inside the campus, so that the other students are protected from any such dubious activities. If they get involved in indiscipline, the conduct and character will be marked as unsatisfactory, endangering the future of the students concerned. The involved students are likely to get severe punishment including fine up to Rs. 10 lakhs and if indicated, dismissal from the institution.

8.5 Hostel facilities are available and are compulsory for all students.

8.6. Attendance & Leave: A minimum of 80% attendance in each academic year for each subject is compulsory - (separate for theory and practical).

8.7. Smoking and consumption of alcoholic drinks and drugs are totally prohibited. Any immoral activity will be considered extremely serious and can result in severe punishment including dismissal from College.

8.8. Rules and Regulations as prescribed should be strictly followed at the college, hospital and hostels.

Note: Redressal of Grievances: Any grievances/ complaints regarding selection and admission can be brought to the notice of the management of the MZMC, Adoor within 24 hours of occurrence of the grievance. All grievances of the candidates/ students which are falling within the provision of the Act XIX of 2006 shall be dealt with by the

Admission Supervisory Committee/ Fee Regulatory Committee.
